To get involved you:

Acceptable Items

- Clothing (men/women/children)
- Clothing Accessories
- Shoes and Boots
- Linens, beddings, towels
- Draperies, curtains
- All cloth items

Uncompensated Acceptable Items

- Luggage
- Toys and books
- Jewelry
- Kitchenware
- Sporting Goods and Tools
- Small Appliances

Questions and Answers

Q. How much will we pay for every full standard 26"x36" garbage bag?

A. We will pay \$2.50 per garbage bag (15.5 lbs) of clothes. Cheques will be issued to your organization.

Q. How many garbage bags of clothing donations must a new partner collect?

A. New partners must accumulate 150 full, standard 26"x36" bags (15.5 lbs) in their account prior to being paid. Once this minimum is met partners will be compensated on request, based on our regular payment schedule.

Q. How does clothing pick up work?

A. A minimum of 20 full bags are required for pick up and must be arranged at least 2 weeks in advance.

Q. How does drop off work?

A. Donations under 20 full bags can be dropped off at our Distribution Center and will be compensated at a rate of 20 cents per pound.

Q. How can you promote your clothing drive?

A. You can create awareness by placing posters in high traffic areas, placing announcements in your newsletter, distributing flyers, reminding people to collect from family and friends.
